MSG Robert Kenneth "Ken" McQuaig, 73, passed away peacefully surrounded by family at his Euless, Tx home on July 26, 2021, after a lengthy battle with cancer. Ken joined the Army after graduating high School and would go on to serve at numerous duty station along with oversea tours in Korea and Germany.

Ken was a Patriot and decorated Army veteran who served 15 years active duty and served another 15 years in the Army National Guard. After retiring from the Army, he worked for the Texas Workforce Commission.

Ken was born on July 22, 1948 in Jacksonville, FL to the late Ira William McQuaig, Jr. and Lola Mae Hewitt McQuaig. He graduated from Charlton County High School in Folkston, GA. He loved hunting and was a dog father to many rescued dogs. Throughout his life, he carried on a passionate love affair with ice cream and McRib sandwiches, and firmly believed that yelling at the T.V. helped his football team play better and that dousing every wound in peroxide was a necessary action.

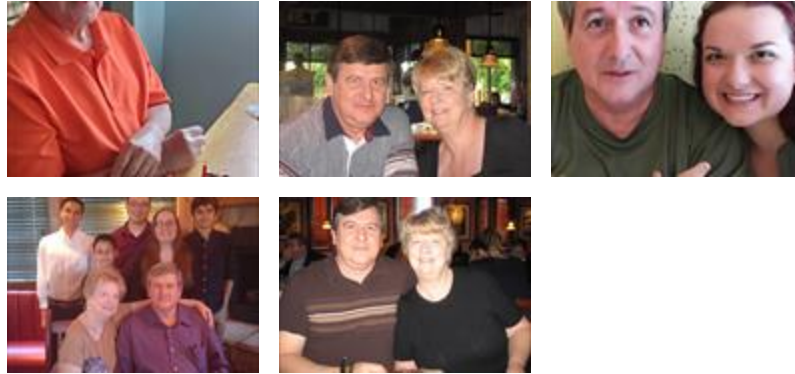

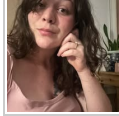
